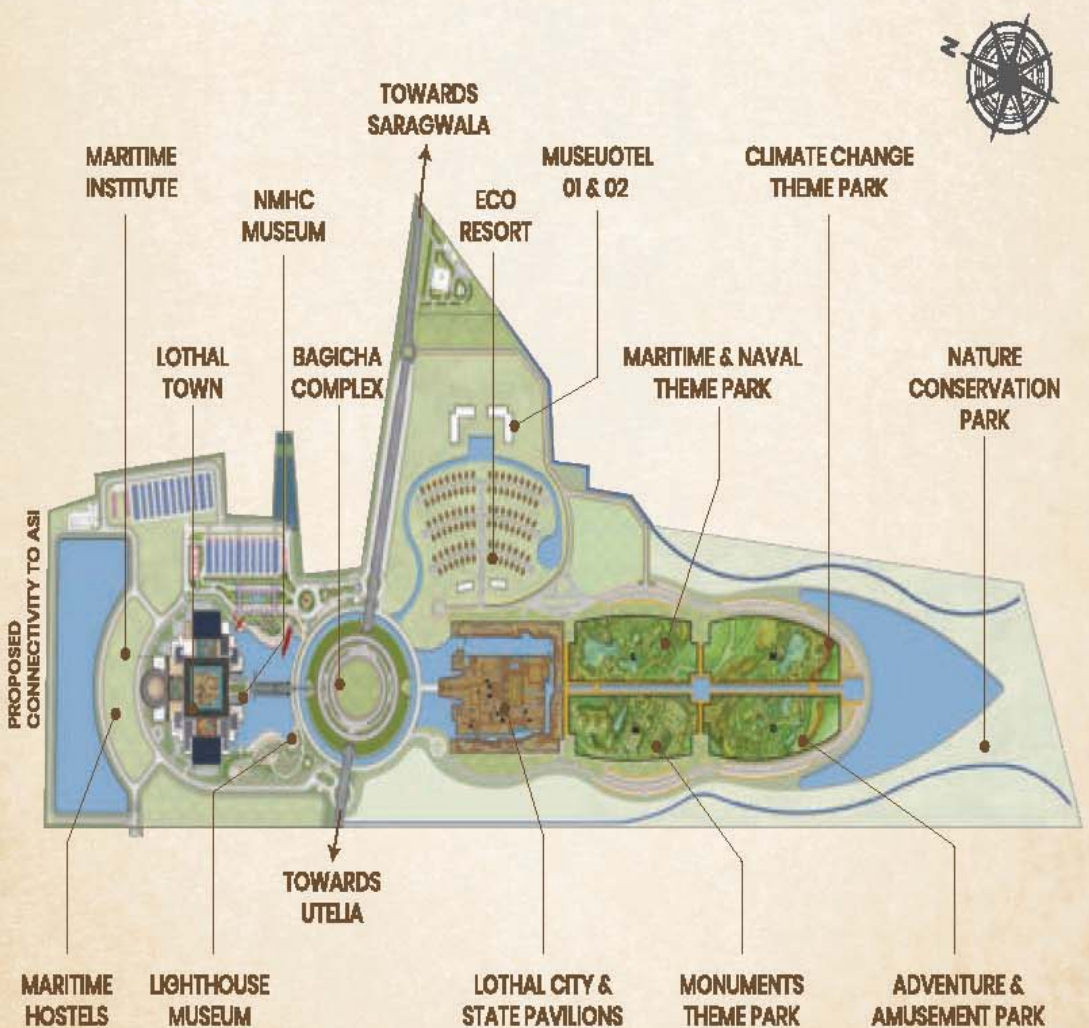

It is one of the prominent cities of the ancient Harappan civilization dating to 2600 BCE. Here, archaeological excavations have discovered the oldest manmade dockyard, over 5000 years old. Setting up a maritime heritage complex at such an important location will befit the historical importance of Lothal and help it develop into a place of extraordinary and unparalleled maritime heritage.

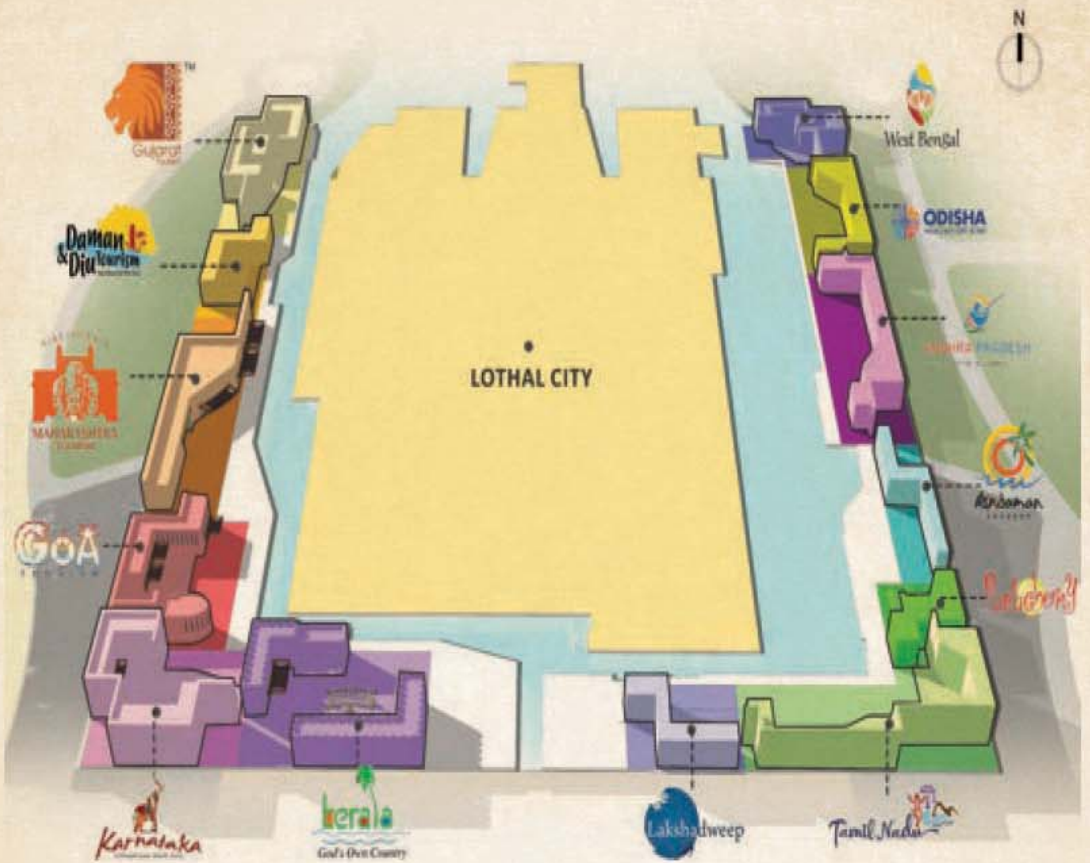

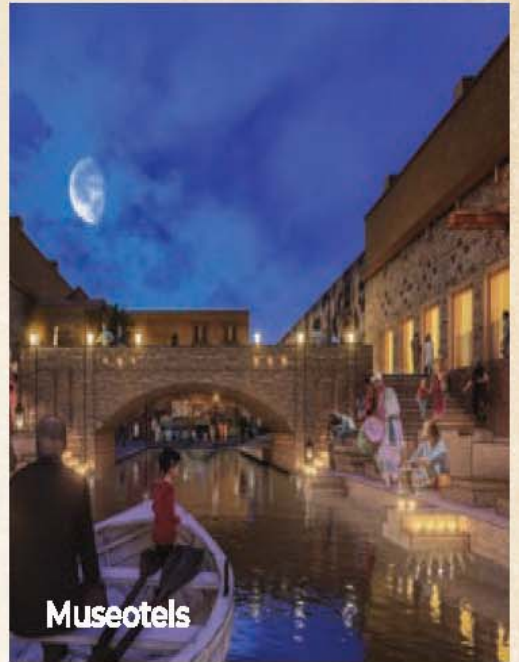

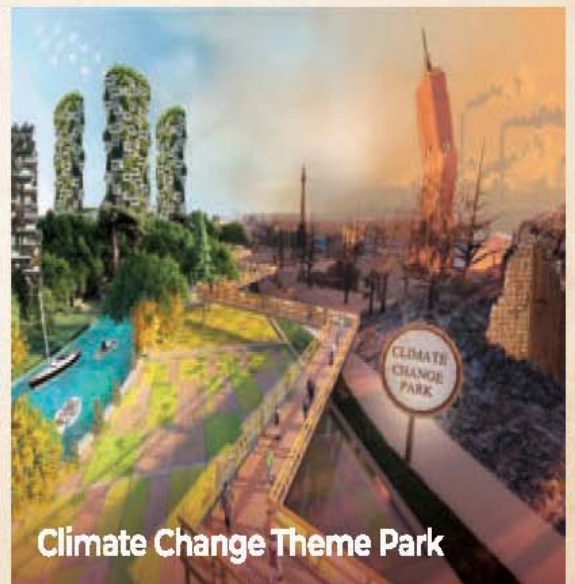
